Alejandro Munoz is vice president, Americas, which includes the U.S., Canada and Latin America regions, and Global Production. He leads the Americas Operations Committee and is also a member of the Pioneer Enterprise Leadership Council.

Having worked at Pioneer for more than 25 years, Alejandro has served in a number of positions around the world. He began his career as quality control manager in Latin America in 1981. Two years later, Alejandro became responsible for market development and production for Central America, Andean Pact and the Caribbean.

He was then promoted to operations manager, Pioneer Mexico in 1988, and was appointed general manager of Híbridos Pioneer de México, S.A. de C.V. in 1991. Alejandro was named Pioneer general manager, Argentina in 1999, and promoted to director, Latin America in 2004. In 2005, he moved to Switzerland to serve as Operations director, Europe, and was then promoted to vice president, Europe Operations, in 2006. Prior to his current assignment, Alejandro was vice president and regional director for North America.
